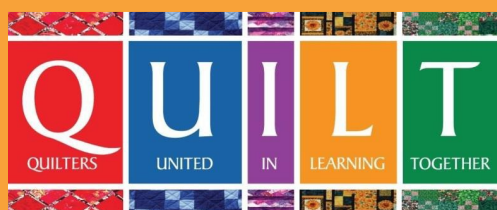

Tonight's Program: Now What? Finishing School for Your Quilt by Kate Eelkema

Kate is from Minnesota and is a NQA Certified Judge. To become a certified judge of this caliber it takes several steps, lots of paperwork, and finally appearing before a panel.

Kate spoke of several things to work on, look for and have in your quilts that, if being judged, will stand out with the Judges. Always measure and square up your quilts. Borders, what kind, how many and techniques to improve the look and style of our quilts. Kate showed many different tools to help mark your quilts and reminded us to always remove marking lines before giving them to be judged. She discussed types of batting, backing, basting, and binding techniques. She also discussed hanging sleeves, how to make them and gave the guild members resources for further study to finish quilts.

The board will look hard at the policy of vendors at meetings and bring it up at the next meeting.

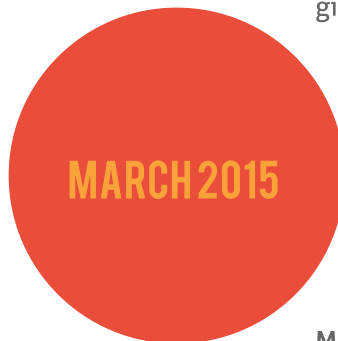
