ContactBox...What is it?

How many times have you been out and about, needed to call someone from the guild, and...your directory isn't in your purse. You had it with you at guild and you left it in your quilting bag. Or...you change purses and it isn't big enough to fit your directory in. Oh well, you probably won't need it...wrong! You need to call, text or email someone from the group. Wouldn't it be great to have all of the information from the directory in your hand, just a click away??

If you have a smartphone, then have we got a deal for you. ContactBox is the answer. ContactBox is an app available FREE from your app store. This is an electronic directory. Our directory has been entered into this amazing app and can be shared with you. Not only will you have the information from the directory...with the touch of just one button, you can call, text or email any person in the directory...right from your phone!



The process is simple! Download the app to your smartphone. Once you have it installed, simply let Barb Hamernick, our membership chair, or Kathy Garringer, our reigning queen, know that you are ready, and they will text you a link. When you receive the link, just click on it and the entire directory will download into your app. Voilá!!!! You have all that wonderful information at your fingertips!
