QUILT SHOW 2019 Laura Speer:

- **There** is a quilt show workshop on Friday, Oct 12, from 9:30-3. We will be making additional drapes for the quilt show. We need at least 4-6 more people. The only sewing is a straight stitch on each drape. You should bring your sewing machine, extension cord, scissors and straight pins. We have four large spools of black polyester thread. If you have spool holder for large spools please bring it. You may also bring your own black thread if you prefer. We won't be using a lot of thread. If you don't want to sew, you can come help us cut. Bring a sack lunch if you like and drinks and dessert will be provided. For more info - call Laura Speer 479-264-9792.
- **Susan** Cleveland's 3-hr class, "Piping Hot Curves", will be on Friday, likely from 9am-12pm. \$40 Maximum attendance is 20.

SPEAKER: KELLY CLINE



Kelly Cline began quilting 5 years ago at age 52. Kelly grew up in the 70s when calligraphy was popular. She enjoyed filling orders for her art at craft fairs, and sold some of her own creations for years. Then she got weary with it. She looked for something else to catch her interest. While she was working at a book store, she read all of Barbara Brackman's quilting books. Someone invited her to attend their guild meeting, and when she looked around at the group, she felt so at home, she thought, "these are my people!" Little did

she expect to learn that Barbara is part of her guild!

Someone offered to sell her a long arm machine. She opted for a new one, and got to work. Calligraphy develops muscle memory, and this made her a natural at quilting on the long arm. She loves to preserve cherished needlework from the past, and to share her journey with us.



The featured quilt with David's letter is a tablecloth. It has 5 layers: a backing (sheet. I use sheets to back all of my quilts!), layer of 80/20 batting, layer of wool batting, a satin sheet, then the tablecloth.

Kelly's advice to us:

- Do not practice on things that don't matter. Use the good stuff.
- NEVER store your quilts in black trash bags! They may end up in the garbage!
- *Comparison is the thief of joy.*
- Do what brings you joy!
- 1 cup of hot water, a heaping spoon of baking soda, rubbing alcohol will take out sharpie marks.



Kelly quilted this randomly placed Dresden Plate to the right for a fellow quilter with swirls, bringing the layout and design alive. This quilt was featured in Mary Kerr's book, "Twisted: Modern Quilts with a Vintage Twist."



Notice the lace on the tea towel to the left.

Q.U.I.L.T. BLOCK OF THE MONTH October, 2018

: 6.5" Patriotic Pinwheels Block (unfinished)

All seams are 1/4".

Version #1 (Simple)
for each block, cut

Two 3 7/8" white squares
two 3 7/8" red or blue squares



To make the block

Cut each square in half diagonally. Sew colored and white triangles together into squares. Trim dog ears and press toward the colored fabric. Arrange squares as shown in picture and assemble.

Version #2 (Complex) (photo on next page)
For each block, cut:

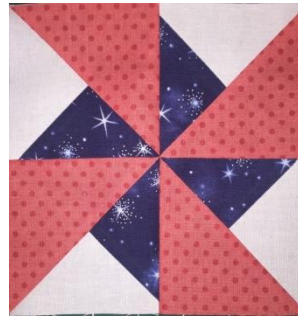
Two 3 7/8" red or blue squares

One 4 1/4" red or blue square (of a different fabric) one 4 1/4" white square

To make the block:

Cut each 3 7/8" square in half diagonally. Cut each 4 1/4" square in half diagonally twice (cutting an "X" through the square). Arrange large and small triangles as shown in the picture. Sew small colored and white triangles together. Trim dog ears and press seams toward the colored fabric. Sew bi-colored triangles to the larger triangles. Trim dog ears and press seams

toward the larger triangle. Arrange squares as shown in picture and assemble.

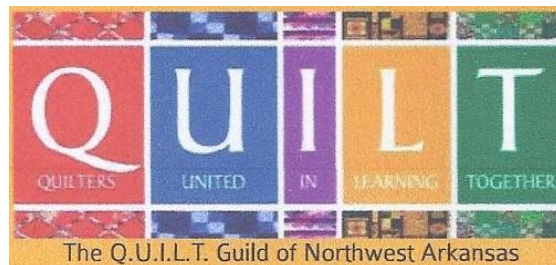
