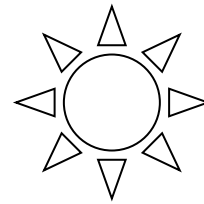

Wedding Anniversary. We wish you many more.

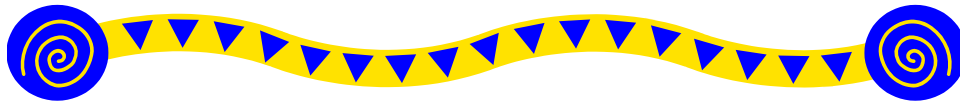

enjoy each day.

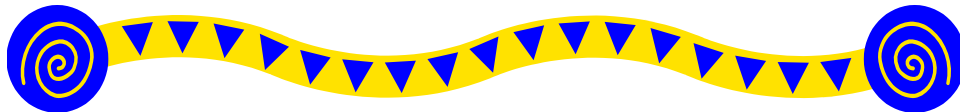
